



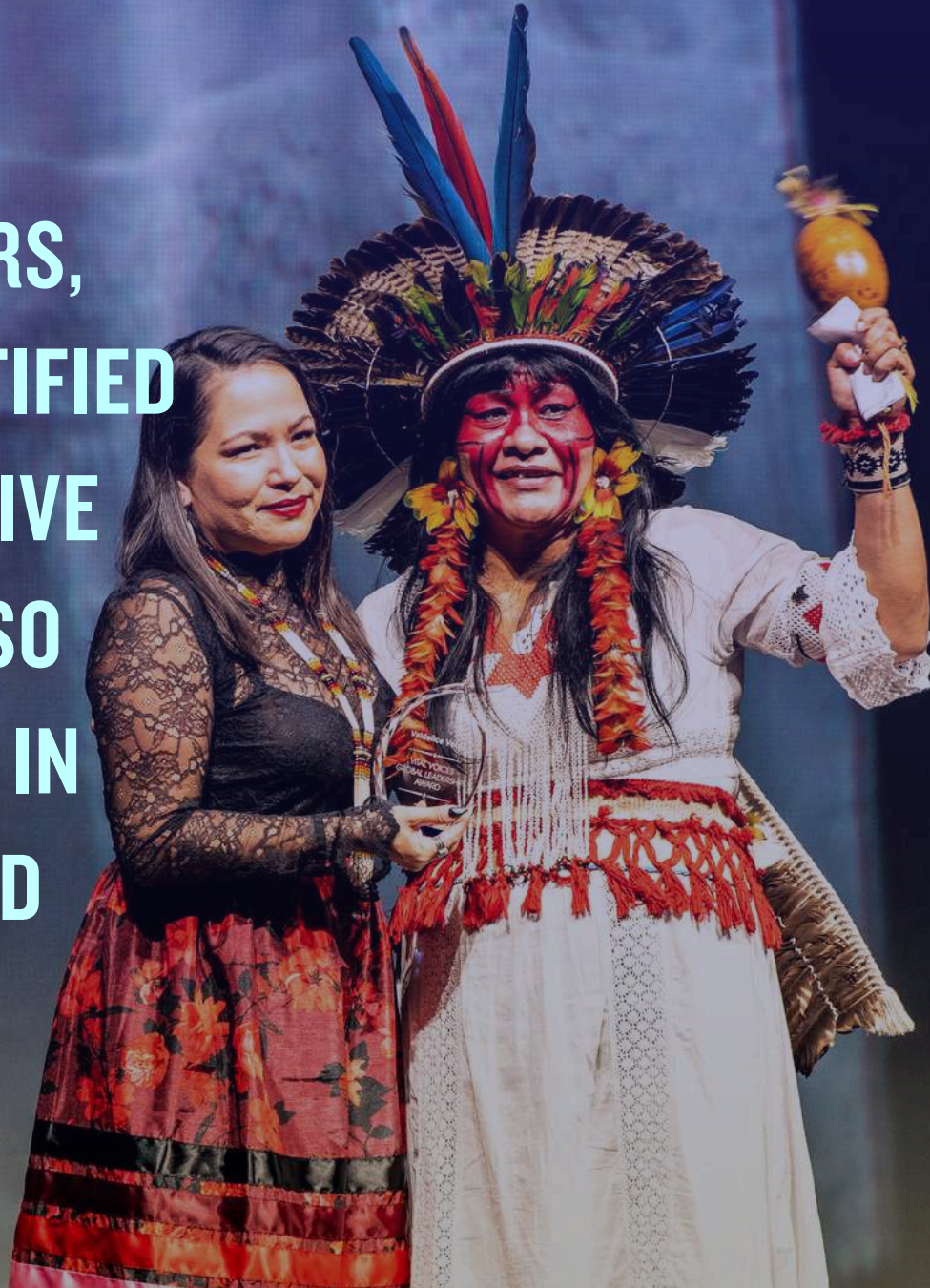

A trailblazing force in global entertainment, Dame Donna Langley oversees NBCUniversal's film and television studios, including Universal Pictures, DreamWorks Animation, and Universal Television, where she has redefined Hollywood by championing diverse storytelling that reflects the world we live in. The first British woman to lead a major studio, Langley has proven that inclusion drives both creativity and commercial success. Honored by the Queen as a Dame Commander and named among Business Insider's 10 People Transforming Business, she is also a longtime Vital Voices Board Member and Global Ambassador, dedicated to mentoring the next generation of women leaders.

SUSIE WOLFF

Susie Wolff MBE is the Managing Director of F1 Academy and a pioneering motorsport leader whose career spans elite racing and team leadership. Susie rose from championship-winning karting to professional competition in Formula Renault, DTM with Mercedes-Benz, and ultimately Williams Racing in Formula 1, becoming the first woman in 22 years to take part in a Formula 1 race weekend at the British Grand Prix. A passionate advocate for women in sport, she founded Dare to Be Different and has been recognised with an MBE and an Honorary Fellowship from the University of Edinburgh. Susie now leads F1 Academy to expand pathways for female talent across motorsport, and is the author of the Sunday Times bestselling memoir *Driven*.

SUSAN WOJCICKI TECH FOR IMPACT AWARD

A visionary tech leader and one of Silicon Valley's most influential figures, Susan Wojcicki led YouTube from 2014 to 2023, shaping it into the world's largest digital video platform and a global force for creativity and connection. As Google's 16th employee, she helped build the company's advertising business and was instrumental in Google's 2006 acquisition of YouTube. Named one of Time's 100 Most Influential People, Wojcicki championed gender equality in tech, advocated for STEM education for girls, stronger parental leave policies, and greater representation of women across the industry. Her legacy continues to inspire a more inclusive and human-centered vision for technology.



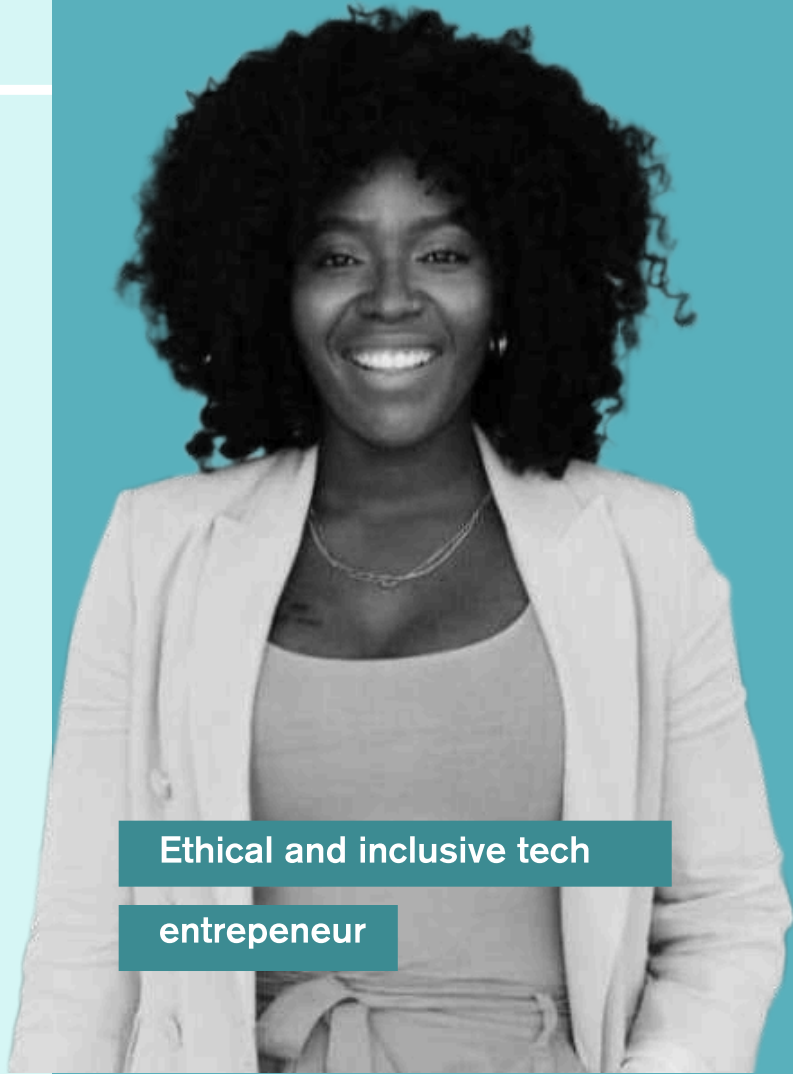

SEYI AKIWOWO

Seyi Akiwowo is a global leader in technology governance and digital trust & safety, helping to reframe online gender-based violence as an issue of institutional duty of care and accountability. At 23, she became the youngest Black female Councillor in East London, after graduating from the London School of Economics. She founded Glitch in 2017, growing “Fix the Glitch” into Europe’s leading nonprofit tackling online abuse. Her work helped shape UK debates that informed the Online Safety Act, and she has advised platforms including TikTok and Pinterest, and institutions such as the UN, OECD, European Parliament and UNESCO. She has been recognised as a TEDxLondon speaker, UN Goalkeeper and Amnesty International Human Rights Defender, among other honours.

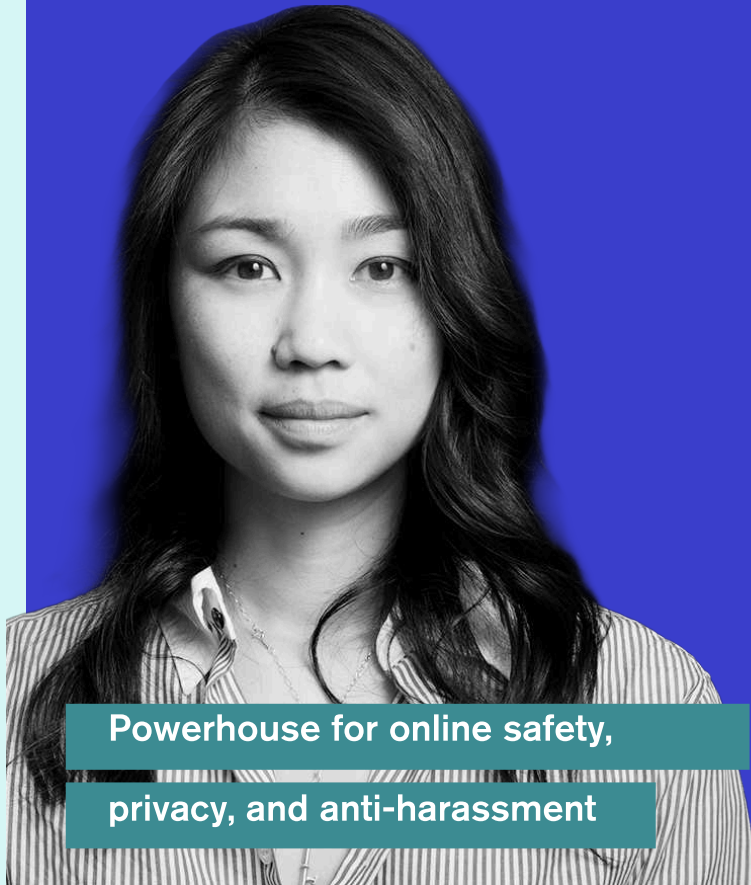

TRACY CHOU

Tracy Chou is an entrepreneur and software engineer well-known for her work advocating for diversity and inclusion in tech.

Motivated by personal experience in countering online harassment, and drawing on professional experience as an early engineer at social media companies like Facebook, Pinterest, and Quora, she founded the tech startup Block Party to build end-user solutions for online safety and privacy. Tracy has been recognized as one of TIME Magazine's Women of the Year, MIT Technology Review 35 Innovators under 35, and Forbes Tech 30 under 30, and she was a Terman Fellow and Mayfield Fellow at Stanford University. Tracy is an affiliate of the Berkman Klein Center for Internet and Society at Harvard Law School and was a 2025 Shorenstein Fellow with the Shorenstein Center at Harvard Kennedy School.

FARWIZA FARHAN

Farwiza Farhan is a forest conservationist working to protect, conserve, and restore the Leuser ecosystem in Sumatra, Indonesia. Leuser is the last place on Earth where rhinos, tigers, elephants, and orangutans still roam in the wild. Farhan firmly believes that conservation should not be an exclusive club, but rather a network of stakeholders—from Indigenous communities to ecologists, lawyers and policymakers, international nonprofits and private sectors—sharing this planet together. Farhan is the chairperson of Forest, Nature and Environment Aceh Foundation (Yayasan HAkA). She focuses primarily on policy and advocacy, working to increase meaningful access and deepen the involvement of women in policy matters pertaining to their environment and livelihood.

SHIRIN MUSA

Shirin Musa is a leading women's rights activist and founder of Femmes for Freedom. Her activism has led to major legislative and policy reforms, including coining the term marital exploitation, now recognized in Dutch law as a form of domestic servitude and human trafficking. Her work has been acknowledged by the Council of Europe and informed EU policy to strengthen consular and legal support for victims. Shirin has initiated landmark legal test cases and remains a prominent voice in grassroots activism, legal reform, politics, academia and media. Her work has been featured in international outlets such as The Economist, BBC and Le Monde, and she has received numerous national and international awards.
